The conversation provided a valuable opportunity to discuss INDOPACOM-specific emerging technology Security Cooperation (SC) opportunities and funding avenues, DoD-wide innovation priorities, and the challenges of bringing new ideas into a complex and evolving environment.





Review of foundational documents defining priorities and recognizing national security challenges allow us to more strategically align actions and necessary interagency coordination.

Attendees included investors, industry leaders, and government partners, all of whom are working at the intersection of emerging technology and national security. The discussion led to a robust exchange of ideas and deep dives into pivotal national security-related topics – particularly, the importance of building an emerging tech readiness ecosystem to bolster integrated deterrence efforts ensuring the U.S., along with its partners and allies, maintain advantages against near-peer competitors.

Attendees discussed how to bring new technology opportunities developed by start-up investors, to the established defense industrial base community, as well as the landscape and decision-makers involved in ally and partner defense capability development. Attendees left the session with the knowledge of U.S. defense priorities, case studies of successful integration of emerging technologies, and a stakeholder map of how to navigate the complexities of the DoD SC landscape.
